#### NOTICE OF RACE

##### 1. Organising Authority

1.1 Organised by the Cowes Corinthian Yacht Club in association with the Portcullis Sailing Club.

##### 2. Rules

2.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020.

##### 3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1 All boats entering the regatta will be allocated a handicap by the Joint Banks Handicap Committee based on the information provided. The entries may be split into two classes at the discretion of the Race Committee once the size of the entry is known.
- 3.2 All boats shall have a fixed keel with a minimum of two fixed berths and in living mode.
- 3.3 Outboard engines and anchors must be stored in board whilst racing.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form and paying the required entry fee.

##### 4. Fees

4.1 Entries shall be made on the attached form and returned to the Regatta Secretary, Portcullis SC, 14 Motspur Park, New Malden, Surrey KT3 6PN by 28<sup>th</sup> May. The fee for the event is £42.00 per boat.

##### 6. Sailing instructions

6.1 The Sailing instructions will be emailed to each competitor on or after 11<sup>th</sup> June 2018.

##### 7. The Courses

- 7.1 The racing area will in the Central Solent starting from the RORC, Clubhouse Startline.
- 7.2 Courses using laid or fixed or navigation marks will be broadcast on VHF and texted to the nominate mobile phone.
- 7.3 A list of marks to be used will be issued with the Sailing Instructions.

##### 8. Penalties

8.1 RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## **9. Haul Out Restrictions**

9.1 Boats shall be afloat by 0830 on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> June and not hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

## **10. Radio Communications**

10.1 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

## **11. Prizes**

11.1 The Trade Wind Trophy and Leigh Pemberton Trophy will be awarded at the Prizegiving Supper at the Cowes Corinthian Yacht Club, Cowes on Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> June.

## **12. Risk Statement**

12.1 Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats, and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- (f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance as is available in Cowes, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.
- (g) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.

## **13. Insurance**

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 Sterling per incident or the equivalent.
